Application for the 2021 Award

What is the “Striving for Excellence” Scholarship?

The “*Striving for Excellence*” scholarship is a \$7,500 award for post-high school education at a four-year college or university. The scholarship is renewable for 3 additional years of post-high school education for a total of \$30,000 when the conditions of the scholarship, as set forth below, are met.

- a. Student must maintain a B (3.0) average and submit an official transcript to the committee prior to each annual grant.
- b. Each year the student must submit a letter to the committee explaining their continued “*Pursuit of Excellence*”.
- c. Freshman year grant will be paid at the beginning of the second semester or as soon as requirements have been met. Subsequent grants will be paid prior to the first semester if transcripts and letter from prior year are submitted on time.

Who can apply?

Juniors who have been enrolled at Southwick Regional School since the beginning of their sophomore year and who plan on continuous enrollment through their graduation. They must also live in Southwick, Tolland or Granville.

Selection Process

Students will not be considered for a scholarship unless their application and all supporting documents are mailed by the deadline. A review committee will meet and narrow the applicants down to the finalists. Finalists must be available for an interview in early May. Scholarship winner will be announced during the Spring Awards assembly at Southwick Regional School the following day. The scholarship will be based on the following criteria:

- a. A review of the applicant’s sealed transcript of high school grades.
- b. A letter of reference from an individual who has known the student while the student has attended Southwick Regional School and who has supported the student’s “*Pursuit of Excellence*”.
- c. A review of the applicant’s essay.
- d. The interview.

B. What lessons from your pursuit of excellence will you apply to your future education?
