THE COMMUNITIES: Southwick is an agricultural and residential community of approximately 9,000 people, located on the southern border of Western Massachusetts. Granville is a small town to the west of Southwick with a population of 1,566. Tolland is a small rural community to the west of Southwick with a population of 516.
